DISCUSSION PAPER SAFETY REGULATION OF HERITAGE RAILWAY OPERATORS

The Independent Transport Safety and Reliability Regulator (ITSRR) is undertaking a review of heritage operations in NSW to assist heritage operators to meet their rail safety obligations.

As part of the review, ITSRR has prepared a discussion paper which aims to identify potential barriers to heritage operators meeting their rail safety obligations and proposes a range of strategies to address those barriers.
