COMMENT INVITED ON GUIDANCE ON NOTIFICATION OF CHANGE AND VARIATION OF ACCREDITATION

The national model rail safety legislation was approved by Commonwealth, State and Territory Ministers in 2006 and is now being implemented across Australia.

The Rail Safety Regulators Panel (RSRP), which includes rail safety regulators from all States and Territories, developed a number of national guidelines to support the national model legislation. In addition to these guidelines the RSRP has developed the following draft document:

- [Guidance on notification of change and variation of accreditation](#) – provides guidance to rail transport operators as to their obligations regarding notification of change and variation of accreditation.

The Independent Transport Safety and Reliability Regulator (ITSRR) invites comment on the draft document from any interested person.
