SAFETY REGULATION OF HERITAGE RAIL TRANSPORT OPERATORS

INDUSTRY INFORMATION SESSION – APRIL 2009

Working with NSW heritage operators to achieve compliance with new requirements for safety management systems is a corporate priority for the Independent Transport and Safety Reliability Regulator (ITSRR).

In February 2009, ITSRR announced it would conduct one-on-one operational hazard analysis workshops with heritage operators during 2009.
