## MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT APPOINTS NEW ITSRR ADVISORY BOARD MEMBER

The NSW Minister for Transport, David Campbell, has confirmed the appointment of Dr David Graham to the Independent Transport Safety and Reliability Regulator's (ITSRR) Advisory Board.

The five-member Board provides independent expert advice to ITSRR and the Minister for Transport on rail safety and transport service reliability issues in NSW. Board members act in a non-management capacity.

Dr Graham has been appointed to the Advisory Board for a term of three years commencing on 15 May 2009.

He has an extensive background in senior executive positions providing leadership in policy development and implementation, service delivery, regulation and stakeholder management.

Dr Graham's career includes more than 20 years in the Australian Public Service as a senior executive of several agencies in the health and social programs sectors.

Since retiring in 2007 as National Manager with the Therapeutic Goods Administration where he had responsibility for regulating the quality, safety and efficacy of therapeutic goods available in Australia, Dr Graham has held several board director positions.

ITSRR's Advisory Board comprises ITSRR's Chief Executive and four external members with experience in one or more of the following: rail safety management systems; safety science; customer service; accident investigation; and/or public administration.
