SAFETY REGULATION OF HERITAGE RAILWAY OPERATORS

INDUSTRY INFORMATION SESSION

Friday 12 December 2008

Working with NSW heritage operators to achieve compliance with new requirements for safety management systems is a corporate priority for the Independent Transport and Safety Reliability Regulator (ITSRR).

In May 2008, ITSRR announced its heritage strategy which comprises initiatives including workshops and a mentoring program for industry and guidance for ITSRR staff to provide informed advice across the heritage operator sector.

This strategy was informed by industry feedback to a November 2007 ITSRR discussion paper which proposed a range of strategies to help heritage operators to meet their rail safety obligations.

To provide an update on the progress of the strategy and gather feedback on proposed future activities, ITSRR will host an industry **information session** in Sydney at the Target Theatre, Powerhouse Museum, 500 Harris Street, Ultimo on **Friday 12 December 2008**, from 10.30 am – 11.30 am. Morning tea will be available from 10.00 am.

The information session will be followed by a rail heritage forum for operators who have a relationship with the Office of Rail Heritage.
